Duration

Depending on the guidelines for course of study, the length of the traineeship is between 8 to 24 weeks.

Contents

You will initially work in the day-to-day business and learn about the processes and structures at Hauni. In addition, you will have the opportunity to work on project-oriented tasks, in which you can apply your knowledge of theory and your practical experience.

Remuneration

In the practical semester of study (technical college 5th semester) as well as in the technical traineeship with an intermediate diploma, you will receive 550 euros per month.

Application and selection procedure

We ask that you submit your application for a traineeship position 3 to 6 months in advance. In your covering letter, please include, inter alia:

- the date at which you would like to start
- the length of the traineeship and
- the area in which you would like to work and/or the topics that you would like to focus on

and attach an overview of your university's demands on the traineeship.

Your application will be forwarded to the departmental head responsible, who will, as the case may be, invite you for an interview. After a successful dialogue, you will receive a traineeship contract.
